The shape section starts with basic shapes: circle, square, rectangle, triangle, heart, and star. After the basic shape coloring pages are pages with different objects and designs that utilize the newly learned shapes. The animal section has a fun assortment of common animals with creative designs so kids can learn popular animals by coloring them. Large 8.5 x 11 inch pages makes this very enjoyable! Whether you are teaching your 2 year old toddler basic shapes or your 4 year old who loves arts and crafts, this is the book for your toddler!
